

TERMS & CONDITIONS-GROOMING

I, _____, do hereby entrust Camelot Kennels, Inc. to care for my pet, _____ for his/her grooming appointment on _____ as well as all future appointments for this year, _____.

I am aware that if my pet is severely matted, that Camelot Kennels may deem it necessary to shave or de-matt my pet. These procedures may have unpleasant consequences such as clipper burn, brush burn or nicks and cuts (depending on the severity of the pet's condition and the demeanor of the pet). If my pet comes in with an infestation of parasites such as fleas or ticks, I give permission for Camelot Kennels to administer a flea dip and use other products to control further infestation. I understand this is not a preventative measure. Camelot Kennels will use all precautions during these procedures, but will not be held responsible for aforementioned side effects.

I agree that I am solely responsible for any and all damage that my pet may cause to the grooming shop, attendants, equipment, other pets or itself through illness, malicious or improper conduct. In the event of an emergency, I have provided a contact number where I can be reached. I authorize Camelot Kennels to do whatever they deem necessary for my pet's well-being, and agree to pay expenses relating to same. I agree to pay current grooming rates, plus any additional services I have requested. I have had the opportunity to ask questions and have grooming procedures explained in full to me, therefore I freely sign this contract.

***This contract and any information regarding your pet is only required one time and will be used for future visits. It is your responsibility to change information as needed.**

***This agreement represents the full and only agreement between the parties. The terms and conditions set forth in this agreement cannot be modified or changed in any way unless agreed to by both parties in writing. I have read, fully understand and agree to the above contract terms.**
